Anthony Netto knows what he is talking about. Even in hospital, the professional golfer suffering from multiple sclerosis recognised the integrative, healing effect of sports activities on the physical and mental well-being of people with physical limitations. Playing golf in spite of his illness was merely a matter of time for Netto.

He has reached his goal with the ParaGolfer by Otto Bock and benefits in all respects: In the meantime, he is once again able to hit the ball well over 200 metres. This speeds up the metabolism, stretches the muscles, reduces spasms and promotes joint mobility. The unique technology of the ParaGolfer brings the player to an upright position, permitting precisely those challenging movements to which Netto owes his 0 handicap.

For years, Anthony Netto has been travelling the world with his ParaGolfer. He works with professional golfers and trains the German national team of handicapped golf players. His stated goal is to reintegrate people with physical limitations into society. It is important to him for sound and disabled players to be at the same level in the game of golf. You play the ball as it lies, and how good your game is depends solely on the skill of the individual.

He and his team are welcome on greens around the world, since the ParaGolfer puts no greater demands on the carefully manicured lawns than a lawnmower. The manoeuvrable vehicle even allows a player to get the ball out of a sand trap. "It lets you play a full, normal game of golf," Anthony Netto exults.

Born in South Africa in 1963, the professional golfer has been wheelchair-bound since the year 2000. With the help of the ParaGolfer which he helped develop, he continues to actively play golf. Netto supports the German Disabled Golf Team, acts as a worldwide consultant for handicapped golfers and is the initiator of the "KidSwing" programme.

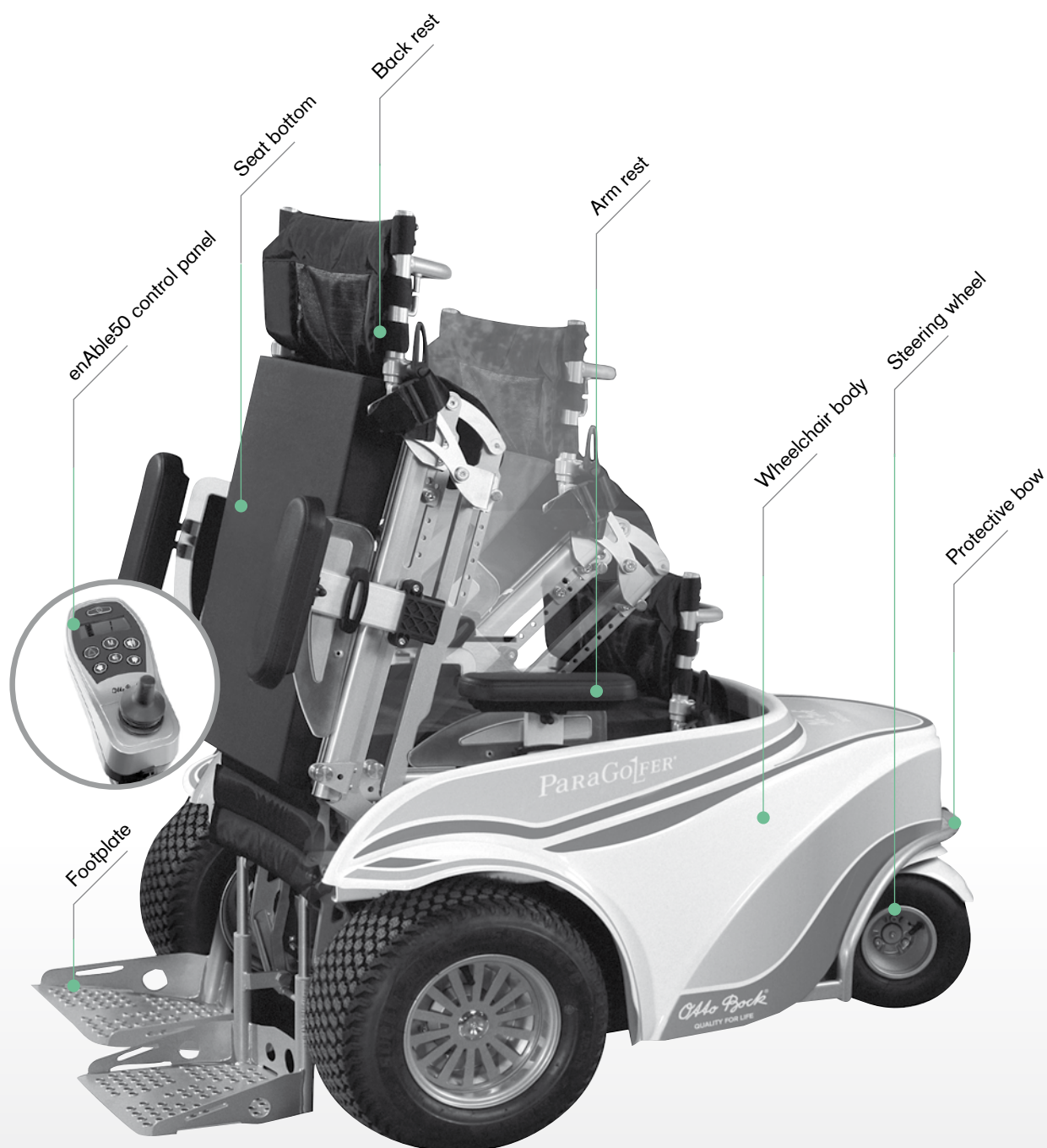

Thanks to its three-wheel design and powerful motors, the ParaGolfer easily conquers slopes of up to 30% (corresponds to 17°). Neither sand traps nor embankments can stop it. If the maximum values are exceeded, the special off-road design automatically turns the vehicle back to a safe position, according to the laws of gravity. The player can rely on extremely secure support in any position. This means freedom to focus on what is really important: Playing the game of golf.
